Contributions to annual change in public service healthcare output volumes by component, England, financial year ending (FYE) 1997 to FYE 2021




Public service healthcare quality and quantity productivity indices, England, financial year ending (FYE) 1996 to FYE 2021








Figure 2: Fixed capital formation in health care, 2000–2016, OECD countries





A: Labor productivity










The bigger productivity picture

Figure 1: Overall economic inactivity has been decreasing since May to July 2022, whereas inactivity because of long-term sickness has generally continued to increase


