<i>Risk factors</i>	<i>Tick</i>
AGE Patient is < 65 years old	
Pain <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Is the patient taking regular Morphine, Oxycodone, tramadol, Fentanyl- Has the patient had a poor past experience of postoperative pain- Or does the patient have a history of chronic pain	
Anxiety <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Does the patient suffer with anxiety, and/ or depression or catastrophize about pain	
Type of surgery <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Is the patient coming in for orthopaedic surgery- Type
